

Faith Development Classes for All Ages Sunday Mornings at 9:45

<u>Toddler Nursey:</u> 9:45am - 12:00pm Our Toddler nursery is available for children ages 2-4 and is lovingly staffed with Safe Sanctuary trained volunteers. Your toddlers will be introduced to the love of Jesus, sing, play and have an allergy free snack during this time.

<u>Children Kindergarten through 5th grade.</u>: Teachers Kristina Skibo and Andi Watson, Rms 106 and 102. Children are nurtured in their faith development with bible lessons to develop lifelong followers of Jesus Christ. We are currently using The Gospel Project curriculum which teaches the Bible chronologically and emphasizes the importance of Jesus in their lives, prayer and reliance on God for all things

Youth Sixth through Twelfth Grades: Teacher, Donovan Kerns, The Loft. Currently studying What if Jesus was Serious? Students will discuss various topics relating to living life as a follower of Christ. This is a discussion-oriented class designed to engage and encourage thinking about the way God intends for us to live and thrive.

Adults:

<u>Candidly Christian:</u> Teachers, Paige Willhite and Emily Sevits. Community Room B. (Off the Gym) This is a group of women who meet with the goal of fellowship and expanding their faith and understanding of God. They have lively and honest discussion covering contemporary and religious studies.

One Accord: Teacher, Harold Cudd. Community Room A. (Off the Gym) One Accord, comprised of senior adults, using Right Now Media and other curriculum. They are supportive, thought provoking and encourage class discussion that will increase their hope and faith and foster love.

J.O.Y Class: Teacher, Kaye Breeding. Room 105 (Off the Gym). This is a praying group of women who love the Lord. They alternate studying a book of the Bible and an inspirational book. They are caring, supportive, sensitive to each other's needs, serious learners, searchers, welcoming, and fun. And they have occasional socials!

<u>Wesleyan Class:</u> Teacher, Janice Robertson. Room 10. This small group uses adult bible study curriculum for men and women of all ages. They make history relevant to daily life by discussing current events with the weekly lessons.

<u>Pastors' Study</u>: Pastors Andrew and Mignelis will be leading this small group Study in Pastor Andrew's office using the resource Right Now Media. The *Be Still Series* is a five-week course based on Brian Heasley's book, *Be Still: a Simple Guide to Quiet Times* that will equip you and your community to learn together how to develop a regular rhythm and deeper daily relationship with God.
